
Water Efficiency

Use of low flow plumbing fixture reduced water use in the building by more than 20%.

Water Efficiency

Landscaping design included use of native and Florida-friendly, drought tolerant plants that did not require permanent irrigation system.

Regional Materials

More than 25% of the materials used in the construction of the building were extracted and manufactured within 500 miles of the project location, including 100% of the carpet and 95% of the drywall.

Recycled Contents

More than 10% of the materials used in the construction of the building include a combination of post-consumer and pre-consumer recycled content, including 100% of the rubber tile in the fitness area.



Indoor Environmental Quality

Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) are commonly found in paints, sealants, and adhesives. The paints, sealants, and adhesives used in this facility contained low or no VOCs thus reducing their potential negative health impact.
