Lot 35 will be closed on Wednesday, April 9 at 8:00 am. Any vehicles left in parking lot 35 after 8:00 am April 9, will be subject to a citation and may be towed at the owner’s expense.

In addition to the lot closures listed below, sections of other lots may be closed to provide prearranged reserved parking for event attendees. Parking lots will be impacted as follows:
