### Interdisciplinary

Work with Applied Behavior Analysis Students to deliver EBPs and supports for school-age children with emotional and behavioral disorders.

Upon exiting the program, students receiving the Project iSED scholarship are required to maintain eligible employment on a full-time or full-time equivalent basis and provide related services to children with disabilities in the school system for a period of two years (if full-time; longer if part-time).
