# BE SAFE, BULLS!

The USF community includes the thousands of students living in apartment communities close to campus. Utilize these tips to improve your personal safety on-the-go and in your residence while attending USF.

### **PERSONAL SAFETY**

- Walk in well-lit and well-traveled areas.
- Carry a flashlight (a keychain flashlight is convenient) in case you find yourself in a dark area.
- Avoid walking alone after dark.
- Make a safety plan with friends. Tell them where you are going and when you will get back.
- Do not drink anything that you did not open or mix yourself.
- Go out together, come home together; always use the "buddy system" when you are going to a party or a bar.
- Take a RAD self-defense course with University Police. Call 813-974-2859 to reserve a spot.

#### **HOME SAFETY**

- Lock all doors and windows.
- Don't hide spare keys outside your residence.
- If you have a sliding door, place a long piece of wood in the floor track to prevent the door from being opened.
- Keep your outside light on at night to deter criminals.

Trust your instincts.

Always report suspicious behavior to the police.

#### VEHICLE/PROPERTY SAFETY

- Always have your keys in-hand when approaching your vehicle.
- Be aware of surroundings.
- Never hide a spare key outside your vehicle.
- Do not personalize your car; it may give criminals information they can use against you.
- Do not stop to help a motorist; call law enforcement to assist.
- If you think someone is following you, don't drive home. Drive to a police station or 24-hour business.
- Register your bike with Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office (813-276-2548) to help with its recovery if stolen.

## OFF THE GIRID TASKFORCE

Off the Grid is USF's off-campus safety taskforce, made up of students, Hillsborough County government and Sheriff's Office officials, and University Police, and is chaired by the Dean of Students. Our objectives are:

- To raise safety awareness of students living off campus
- To provide safety information to students preparing to move off campus
- To create partnerships with local officials and apartment staff to improve safety measures
- To develop student residential relationships with communities adjacent to campus.
