Cyber Criminal Pleads Guilty in Federal Court

In a North Carolina federal court, a member of an international cybercrime group pled guilty to computer fraud and conspiracy to commit wire fraud. Using hacker tools, the dark web, and cryptocurrency the group targeted many U.S cities and businesses with data theft and ransomware attacks. Sentencing is scheduled for August 2025. Raytheon Fined for Cybersecurity Lapse

The U.S. Department of Justice announced an \$8.4 million settlement with Raytheon, the Nightwing Group, and RTX over alleged cybersecurity noncompliance in 29 defense contracts between 2015 and 2021. The case, brought by a whistleblower under the False Claims Act, focused on Raytheon's use of a noncompliant network that lacked NIST-required protections and controls. Read more from JD Supra here.
