1 Submit Application

Submit **graduate application online** with \$30 application fee. To apply to the correct program, select the following options:

2 Submit Documents

Download, complete and upload the following documents to your online application:

- Resume/CV
- **Professional Statement**
(500 words)
- **Personal Statement**
(500 words)
- **Three letter of recommendation forms**

Please provide three letters of recommendation. Select a cross-section of references, including employers, faculty or other individuals who have evaluated your work and can speak to your academic abilities and/or related paid social work or volunteer experience. Provide details about each recommender with an email

*address, and an email to the online recommendation form will be sent to the recommender. **Personal References DO NOT include relatives.***

- Unofficial transcripts from each institution of higher learning
(Minimum GPA of 3.0 required)
- Undergraduate field internship evaluation

***GRE:** Not required. However, applicants with a GPA less than 3.0 can submit GRE scores for consideration. Quantitative (144 or higher) and Verbal (153 or higher)*



3 Mail Official Transcripts
