- 1. **Call to Order:** Dr. Heller called the meeting to order at 10:47 a.m.
- 2. **Approval of Minutes:** The minutes of the meeting held on April 7, 2025, were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes was made, seconded, and unanimously approved.
- Update on the Institutes and Center Initiative: Eric Kern introduced the Institutes and Centers Compliance and Strategic Planning Initiative.
  - The initiative involves the Office of the Provost, the Office of Decision Support, and the Office of Research and Innovation.
  - The goal is to align with Board of Governors (BOG) requirements and strategize institutes and centers to support the research enterprise.
- **Interdisciplinary Center Preparation Grant Reviews:** The committee thoroughly reviewed nine highly competitive Interdisciplinary Center Preparation Grant applications, focusing on selecting candidates for funding. Following this evaluation, the council approved funding for the following four proposals:
  - Yael Bensoussan, 1640 Planting the Seeds of Collaboration: The Fortification of Cross-Disciplinary Programs for The Institute for Voice and Hearing Innovation, \$300K over two years
  - Tingting Zhang, 1636 The Center for Biological and Food Innovations in AI and Robotics for Children's Nutrition and Health (Bio-FAIRCH), \$300K over two years
  - Stephanie Carey, 1641 ASTRA (Aerospace Science, Technology, Research and Applications) Center, \$150K over two years
  - Claire Smith, 1643 DREAM-AI Center Development: Dynamic Rest Enhancement and Measurement using Artificial Intelligence, \$150K over two years
