Federal Student Government

- Met with Dr. Tadlock in St. Pete to express our priorities for the spring semester.
- Met with Dr. Dosal and Dean Crume in Tampa to continue conversation on how to aid students in academic relief. We also expressed our spring semester priorities in this initial meeting.

- Made significant progress on solidifying out legislative agenda to lobby in Tallahassee this spring semester.
